## SB 348 -1 Amendments

The Oregon Association of Community Corrections Directors respectfully requests an amendment to the -1 amendments to SB 348 to be included in the list of law enforcement officers authorized to acquire, possess or use a large capacity magazines.

Community Corrections employs credentialed parole and probation officers who are certified officers through the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training. Parole and Probation officers are first responders in local communities and part of the law enforcement system working with justice involved individuals who have demonstrated some capacity for anti-social behavior and violence in some cases. Parole and Probation officers are trained in the use of firearms and high capacity magazines, and should have the same exemptions as peace officers as it relates to this law.
