Rogue River Valley Irrigation District (RRVID) is located in Medford Oregon; with patrons in the cities of Medford, Central Point, White City and Eagle Point. The district serves approximately 1,391 patrons on 9,122 acres. Crops of fruits and vegetables, hay and alfalfa and fruit trees are grown in the area.

Our district was able to pipe a section of our irrigation canal system to continue to enhance habitat for Southern Oregon/Northern California Coast Coho and other threatened and endangered species. The pressurized water this project created has helped conserve water and electricity and above all it has improved water quality and aquatic habitat in the rivers, creeks and stream in the Rogue Basin.

RRVID worked with Farmers Conservation Alliance (FCA) to develop a system improvement plan, as well as a modernization plan so we can continue to pipe our irrigation canal system to obtain our goal to enhance habitat, conserve water and improve water quality. Our next project is in the initial stage; we are reviewing options that will be the most beneficial based on the drought impact to the environment and irrigation patrons, of the last decade and more.

I urge you to support the important funding components in HB 3124 and ensure that state match funding for irrigation modernization projects remains a part of the final bill. Thank you for your attention to this important matter.
