Chair Gelser Blouin and Vice Chair Robinson, and members of the Committee, thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony in support of HB2447A.

HB2447A makes amendments to the DHS/OHA right to make a claim against a decedent's account and it clarifies that there's a cutoff for DHS/OHA claims to be paid from the decedent's funds on deposit. Oregon credit unions are in support of the clarity provided in HB2447A and appreciate the amendment in the House to apply the provisions of this bill in Oregon credit union statutes.
