I am a community college Instructional Dean and urge you to vote no on HB 2996 and HB 3223 as they would cause many harmful effects such as putting patient health and safety at risk, lowering the quality of patient care, undermining and devaluing the dental assisting profession, and worsening the existing shortage of qualified providers.
