For the record, my name is Kevin Campbell, and I am the Executive Director of the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police. I am here today on behalf of the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police and the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association to offer testimony in strong support of HB 2070. I believe that this is the least we can do to honor the sacrifices of our brave police officers and their families.
