The Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board requires more revenue.

- **Due to increasing inflation and higher interest rates, current and proposed funding is not sufficient to meet the operational requirements to protect and enhance Oregon's precious and irreplaceable watersheds.
- ** "..Article XV, section 4b, of Oregon Constitution..." requires structural growth in funding allocations to ensure compliance.
- **"...The Natural Resources Subaccount of Parks and Natural Resources Fund..." should be two separate and distinct 'Restricted Use Funds.'
- *** "The Oregon Agricultural Heritage Program (OAHP) requires serious review.

The **OAHP** should have its' own FUND separate and distinct from all funding sources AND should be designated as a "Restricted Use Fund" to guard against wily and despicable Oregonian Legislators from raiding the FUND for other purposes.
