Vote *No* on this bill. This bill allows for people who just turned 18, are write-in candidates, or who recently became citizens of the U.S. to have different qualifications for holding office of Precinct Committee Person (PCP) than existing citizens. This bill allows them to not have been registered to any political party for which they are wanting to hold office for any length of time. This allows non-citizens to become citizens without registering with a political party and then to become a PCP without having to qualify as existing citizens do. Write-in candidates and 18 year-olds can also become a PCP this way.
