Dear Chair Manning, Vice-Chair Thatcher, and members of the committee:

My name is Anna Braun with Braun Law LLC testifying on behalf of the Association of Oregon Counties. **AOC strongly supports HB 2806.**

HB 2806 will allow sensitive material pertaining to cybersecurity to be discussed in an executive session. AOC will also testify in support of a companion bill, HB 2490, that allows an exemption from public records for cybersecurity issues.

Cybersecurity issues are sensitive and having the information in the wrong hands is a disaster for counties. Unfortunately, county governments have been targets of cybersecurity attacks. AOC Governance, Revenue and Veterans steering committee Co Chair Commissioner Yamamoto will testify at the public hearing in support of the measure and tell the committee about a situation that happened in Tillamook County which illustrates the need for the measure.
