



#### HB 2417 (2021)

**\$5 million General Fund** to initiate the crisis hotline center (contract with Lines for Life and Northwest Human Services).

\$10 million General Fund distributed to counties to establish and maintain mobile crisis intervention teams that could respond to crisis in the community.

#### HB 5024 (2021)

\$6.5 million General Fund for Mobile Response and Crisis Stabilization Services (MRSS) that continued expansion of crisis stabilization services, resulting in coverage across the entire life span of Oregonians regardless of insurance status.

#### HB 5202 (2022)

Included \$1.8 million General Fund and 10 positions for ongoing agency operations to support implementation and oversight of the system envisioned by HB 2417, the development of standards for statewide mobile crisis teams, development of Medicaid reimbursement opportunities and business information system and financial management support.
