HB 4081 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Emergency Medical Services Program and Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board within the Oregon Health Authority.

HB 4070 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to modify the amounts of grants for school-based health centers for inflation.

HB 4091

Establishes the Health Insurance Mandate Review Advisory Committee, staffed by the Legislative Policy and Research Director, to meet during interims between sessions of the Legislative Assembly to review any proposed measure sponsored by or submitted to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health if the measure requires health insurance policies to reimburse specified health care providers or to reimburse the cost of a specific service.

HB 4003 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of State Police to study the causes of and ways to address the medical examiner shortage, and to provide the results of the study to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than May 1, 2025.

HB 4150

Authorizes the Oregon Health Authority or a third party to provide electronic notification to a practitioner in certain circumstances when the practitioner's patient has a fatal or nonfatal overdose.

HB 4151 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Task Force on Youth Behavioral Health Workforce.

HB 4092 \*\* \*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Requires the Oregon Health Authority to conduct a study to determine the funding required for

each community mental health program to provide the services and perform the functions required by law related to individuals with behavioral health disorders in specified age groups.

HB 4010

Specifies that flavoring of a prescription drug is not compounding.

HB 4011 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Prohibits cost-sharing on certain health insurance coverage of cervical cancer examinations.

HB 4012 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Prohibits issuers of health benefit plans, health care service contractors or multiple employer welfare arrangements from requiring that drugs that are administered by a health care provider be dispensed at a certain pharmacy or by a pharmacy that is in the provider's network, under specified circumstances.

HB 4149 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires pharmacy benefit managers to be licensed by the Department of Consumer and Business Services beginning January 1, 2025.

HB 4113

Requires an insurer a pharmacy benefit manager, the Public Employees' Benefit Board, the Oregon Educators Benefit Board and a health care service contractor to count payments made by or on behalf of an enrollee for the costs of certain prescription drugs when calculating the enrollee's contribution to an out-of-pocket maximum, deductible, copayment, coinsurance or other required cost-sharing for the drugs.

HB 4136

Expands the exemption from the licensure requirement for certain nurses.

HB 4130

Prohibits a shareholder, director or officer of a professional corporation organized for the purpose of practicing medicine, or a professional corporation organized for the purpose of allowing physicians, physician assistants and nurse practitioners to jointly render professional health care services, from participating in managing the professional corporation, or voting shares in the professional corporation on any issue or corporate action that bears on the ownership, management or governance of the professional corporation, if the shareholder, director or officer is simultaneously a shareholder, director, member, officer or employee of a management services organization with which the professional corporation has a contract.
