HB 4004

Allows the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries to impose civil penalties against a person for violating the child labor laws when the person has paid a civil penalty to the United States Department of Labor for a violation involving the same facts.

HB 4006

Requires a contracting agency to accept from contractors surety bonds in lieu of retainage for construction projects and public improvement contracts.

HB 4115

Modifies the definition of "supervisory employee" to exclude certain strike-prohibited public employees.

HB 4118 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Bureau of Labor and Industries to conduct a comprehensive study of youth apprenticeships in the United States.
