HB 4129 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Department of Human Services and the Oregon Health Authority to contract with up to two agencies to provide agency with choice services to individuals who are older adults or who have disabilities.

HB 4086
Modifies when the Department of Human Services is required to investigate child abuse reports.
