- HB 4125 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Legislative Policy and Research Director to conduct a study on the impact of Senate Bill 242 (2011) on higher education in this state.
- HB 4162 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the purpose of carrying out Oregon's Open Educational Resources (OER) Program.
- HB 4163
Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish a grant program for the purpose of supporting organizations to expand the scope and community reach of college access and success programs.
- HB 4164
Removes the condition on reimbursement for expenses for nonlegislative members of the Sexual Misconduct Survey Council.
