Public Hearing

HB 4063

Requires Metro counties to plan for the housing needs of Metro urban unincorporated lands.

HB 4046

Allows an occupying homeowner outside of an urban growth boundary to site one additional family dwelling unit on the tract of the home.

Work Session

HB 4134 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to provide grants to cities for specified infrastructure projects that will benefit housing developments that will make at least 30 percent of the dwelling units affordable to workforce income households.

HB 4099 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Housing and Community Services Department to guarantee local governments' deferral of system development charges for housing developments.

HB 4058

Creates a residential property wholesaler registration.
