HB 4001 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Task Force on Specialty Courts.

HB 4121 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission, in consultation with the State Department of Agriculture, to create a map of locations of premises licensed to produce marijuana or industrial hemp.

HB 4123 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys to the Department of Justice to fund the management of the Oregon SAE/ SANE Certification Commission by the Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force.

HB 4156

Modifies definitions pertaining to stalking orders and stalking offenses.

HB 4146

Provides that a petition for a Family Abuse Prevention Act order, Elderly Persons and Persons with Disabilities Abuse Prevention Act order or sexual abuse restraining order may be filed in the county in which the abuse occurred.

HB 4160

Modifies the length of time by which a person is considered a student for purposes of determining if conduct is prohibited sexual conduct.
