Provides for the date and time of the convening of electors of the President and Vice President of the United States.

HB 4020 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires an applicant for a commission as a notary public to complete a course of study offered by the Secretary of State before taking the required examination, even if the applicant already holds a commission in Oregon.

HB 4117
