Work Session

SB 1538 A

Specifies the information to be included in county voters' pamphlets. Permits an agent of a candidate to file a translation of a candidate statement with the Secretary of State.

SB 1568

Provides that, for the purpose of specifying the prevailing rate of wage for electrical workers, a locality is the geographical area within which each local union is the exclusive representative for the local union's membership, and the collective bargaining agreement is the collective bargaining agreement to which the local union is a party.

SB 1553 A

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study Oregon's addiction crisis.

SB 1571 A

Requires a disclosure of the use of artificial intelligence synthetic media in campaign communications.

SB 1575 A

Provides that a public body may not include certain provisions relating to payment of defense costs Limits a public body's ability to require a duty to defend the public body in a contract with a person or entity providing architecture, landscape architecture, architectural, engineering, photogrammetric mapping, transportation planning, land surveying services or related services.
