Work Session

HB 4015

Permits a developer of a facility or the governing body of a local government after consulting with the developer to elect to defer regulatory authority to the Energy Facility Siting Council for the siting of a battery energy storage system.

HB 4083

Directs the Oregon Investment Council and the State Treasurer to make efforts to eliminate certain investments in thermal coal companies.

HB 4013 A

Prohibits the Department of Environmental Quality from enforcing the provisions of the producer responsibility program applicable to wine packaging. Sunsets on July 1, 2026.
