Work Session

SB 1557 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Oregon Health Authority to seek federal approval to obtain federal funding to provide services and supports to certain individuals who are under 21 years of age to enable the individuals to live at home.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 1591
Authorizes the Department of Human Services to license adult foster homes serving up to seven residents if the home meets specified criteria and pays the appropriate fee.

SB 1547 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Permits the director of a treatment facility to admit a minor for inpatient substance use disorder diagnosis, evaluation and treatment for up to 14 days with parental consent when the minor objects to the admission.

Work Session

SB 1521 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Modifies the enforcement by the Department of Human Services of the requirements for residential care facilities to use acuity-based staffing tools to ensure sufficient staffing levels to meet residents' scheduled and unscheduled needs at all times.

SB 1579 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Children's Advocacy Center Fund.

SB 1522 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Repeals statutes authorizing the involuntary commitment of an individual based on an intellectual disability.

SB 1585 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Department of Human Services to convene a work group to analyze options available under federal law for a program that allows recipients of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits to use the benefits for hot foods, including restaurant meals.
