Public Hearing

SB 1574

Provides that abuse of a corpse in the first degree involving sexual activity is a sex crime for purposes of sex offender reporting.

Work Session

SB 1575

Provides that a public body may not include certain provisions relating to payment of defense costs in a contract with a person or entity providing architecture, landscape architecture, engineering, photogrammetric mapping, transportation planning, land surveying services or related services.

SB 1587 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Grants certain immunities to children's advocacy centers and to employees and designated agents of children's advocacy centers.

SB 1503 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Task Force on Gun Violence and Suicide Prevention and requires the task force to report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care.
