SB 1538

Specifies the information to be included in county voters' pamphlets.

SB 1533 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases, from 5 to 10, the number of the most commonly spoken languages in each county, other than English, that the Secretary of State must include on a publicly available list and into which the secretary must translate voters' pamphlets.

SB 1539 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Tourism Commission to develop, and coadminister with Sport Oregon, a program for awarding grants to local government bodies to help fund youth sporting events.

SB 1571

Requires a disclosure of the use of artificial intelligence in campaign communications.

Commemorates the 25th anniversary of the founding of Inland Northwest Musicians.

SCR 210

Honors the life and memory of Mike Donahue.
