

HB 4033 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Moves the sunset of the assessment on long term care facilities from July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2032.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The current assessment on long term care (LTC) facilities, or commonly known as nursing facilities, sunsets on June 30, 2026. The governing laws on the assessment are to be repealed on January 2, 2028. The 2018 legislature extended the sunset by six years on the assessment to June 30, 2026, from June 30, 2020, and also the governing laws by six years.

This measure moves the sunset of the assessment to June 30, 2032, and the repeal of the governing laws to January 2, 2034. It allows the Oregon Department of Human Services to continue to collect assessment on LTC facilities for six more years. LTC facility assessments will fetch matching federal funds to provide care for qualified Medicaid beneficiaries.
