Background

SB 455 (2019):

Amended existing statute and added apprenticeship reporting requirements for community college capital construction projects funded in part or in whole b Article XI-G bond proceeds for contracts with a cost of \$8M or more

ORS 350.379:

- Requires community colleges to report annually on the amount of work performed by apprentices, women, and minority individuals under qualified contracts.
- Applies to community college capital projects with qualified contracts solicited, advertise or entered into on or after January 1, 2021.



Background

- Community colleges are not subject to the additional reporting requirements that apply to public universities in SB 1572 (2020).
- This report covers one project at Lane Community College subject to the reporting requirements for qualified contracts entered into in 2022 and continuing into this year.
- No other community college projects funded by Article XI-G bond proceeds are subject to this reporting requirement because those construction contracts were initiated prior to January 1, 2021; and newer projects subject to reporting have not begun construction.
 - We anticipate there will be some additional colleges reporting next year.





Health Professions Building

The new \$32.8 million, 34,683 ft², facility will support the expansion of high-demand Health Professions programs at LCC's main campus in Eugene.

- The new building will allow for the return of LCC's Dental Clinic to the main campus, closer to other academic classes and Health Profession programs.
- It will serve as home to Lane's Dental Hygienist, Dental Assistant, Medical Assistant and Emergency Medical Services programs.
- Expected completion: Summer 2024.
