

SILICON FOREST



Nearly 80 years of investment in Greater Portland by Intel and Tektronix has cultivated a forest of thousands of technology firms and their suppliers. **Intel has invested more than \$49 billion since 1974** to support its global R&D headquarters in Hillsboro.



RELIABLE, LOW-COST ENERGY

Oregon and Washington rank 1st and 2nd in the nation, respectively, in U.S. News & World Report's energy rankings. The rankings are based on electricity cost, grid reliability and renewable energy usage.



HIGHLY EDUCATED WORKFORCE

Greater Portland has the edge on semiconductor talent. More than 90% of the region's workforce in this cluster is employed in subsectors that are at least 25% more competitive than the U.S. average. For example, we have 13 times the average national concentration of semiconductor processing technicians.



Trade in Greater Portland



- Greater Portland is the 10th largest metropolitan exporting region in the U.S. (2021).
- Total Goods Exports in 2021: \$33.8 Billion.
- Exports grew by \$10 Billion (42.2%) just from 2019 to 2021.





- **3,670 companies exported** goods from Greater Portland in 2020 (88% were businesses with less than 500 employees).
- **#16 in FT-Nikkei** ranking of best U.S. cities for foreign businesses 2022.

Trade in Greater Portland



- Computers and Electronic Products is, by far, the largest export sector in Greater Portland – totaling 43% of the value of all exports in 2021.
 - Since 2005, the value of exports in this sector has tripled.
 - Greater Portland is the 3rd largest exporting region in the USA of Computer and Electronic Products.
- In other sectors, compared to other regions the USA, Greater Portland ranks as follows:
 - **Machinery** = 2nd largest
 - **Agricultural Products** = 4th largest
 - **Transportation Equipment** = 11th largest







Value of Exports to Ireland by Ten Largest States, 2022 (millions of USD)




- In 2022, Oregon ranked as the #1 largest exporting state to Ireland.
- About 13% of all U.S. exports to Ireland were from Oregon during this year.

However, exports from Oregon to Ireland increased dramatically in 2022 – increasing by over 3x from 2021.

The Machinery industry saw a dramatic increase in the value of exports. Computers & Electronics almost doubled.

Exports



- Ireland ranked 5th out of all countries in the value of exports from Oregon in 2022.
 - Ireland ranked higher than Japan, South Korea, Israel, and Taiwan
 - Ireland ranked higher than every European country.
- 6.2% of the value of all Oregon's exports went to Ireland in 2022.

Oregon was the largest exporting state to Ireland in Computers and Electronic Products in 2022 and 2020.



- Ireland ranked 5th out of all countries in the value of imports to Oregon in 2022.
 - Ireland ranked higher than Israel, Taiwan, Vietnam, Mexico, and Singapore.
 - $\circ~$ Ireland ranked higher than all other European counties.
- 5.2% of the value of all Oregon's imports were from Ireland in 2022.
- In 2022, Oregon ranked as the 17th largest importing state from Ireland.

While the value of imports from Ireland has fluctuated some in recent years, since 2016 Ireland has remained at least in the top 7 of all countries.




Oregon Imports by Country: 334--Computer & Electronic Products in 2022
