Bill Title: Relating to behavioral health.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Oregon Health Authority, Metro, Cities, Department of Land Conservation and Development, Counties

Summary of Fiscal Impact

Costs related to the measure for cities are indeterminate at this time- see explanatory analysis.

Measure Description

This measure directs local governments to allow a residential facility within an urban growth boundary to be sited on a property without requiring a zone change or conditional permit under certain circumstances. For the purposes of this measure, residential facilities include residential care facilities, residential training facilities, and residential treatment facilities.

Fiscal Analysis

The fiscal impact of the measure on cities is indeterminate. This measure may increase claims and legal challenges for cities related to siting facilities outside of residential areas, and therefore, differently than other residential development. However, the fiscal impact is indeterminate as the number of potential challenges is unknown.

The measure has a minimal impact on counties and no fiscal impact on the Department of Land Conservation and Development, Metro, or the Oregon Health Authority.

The measure takes effect on January 1, 2025.
