Subject:	HB 4134 – Relating to housing Work Session Recommendations

House Bill 4134 directs the Department of Administrative Services to provide grants to cities for infrastructure projects that primarily benefit housing development. The measure requires that the project be within a city's urban growth boundary, that the project will be completed within 24 months after receiving grant funds, and the submission of progress reports on project status.

The measure previously had hearings in the House Housing and Homelessness Committee.

Recommended Changes

The -A5 amendment specifies four infrastructure projects for grant funds, totaling \$7.1 million, and changes the administrator of the grant funding from the Department of Administrative Services to the Oregon Business Development Department.

LFO recommends adoption of the -A5 amendment.
