Subject: HB 4153 – Relating to artificial intelligence
Work Session Recommendations

HB 4153 creates the 14-member Task Force on Artificial Intelligence to examine and identify terms and definitions related to artificial intelligence that are commonly used and understood in technology-related fields. No later than December 1, 2024, the task force must submit a report to the interim committee on information management and technology that includes recommendations for terms and definitions that may be used for state legislation.

The measure has a minimal fiscal impact. Members of the task force who are not members of the Legislative Assembly serve as volunteers and are not eligible for compensation or expense reimbursement. The Legislative Policy and Research Office will support the task force with existing staff.

The measure was reported out of the Joint Committee on Information Management and Technology on February 14, 2024 with a do pass recommendation. The measure takes effect upon passage and the task force sunsets on January 1, 2025.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 4153 be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
