

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 5702 Fee Ratification

SB 5702 is the fee ratification bill for the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Department of Agriculture, Department of Environmental Quality, and the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission. The measure provides the enabling legislation necessary to approve fee changes adopted by these agencies through the Administrative Rules process.

Most of the fees are a result of programs established through prior legislation.

- ODA established two new noncommercial pesticide applicator license types as authorized by HB 4062 (2022).
- DPSST established fees for Private Security Entities, authorized by HB 2527 (2021).
- DEQ established fees for two new programs: the Fuel Tank Seismic Stability Program, authorized by SB 1567 (2022), and the Mattress Stewardship Program from SB 1576 (2022).
- OLCC established an Alcohol Delivery Training Program Review fee, authorized by HB 3308 (2023).

Finally, HECC increased its fingerprint and background check fee for Private Career Schools, last increased in 2013, and ODA adopted a late application fee for hemp growers.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 5702 be reported out do pass.
