OREGON BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Oregon Board of Physical Therapy subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The board consists of eight Oregon residents, including: 4

- five physical therapists (CRAWFORD, LARSON REYNOLDS, **OKUMURA**, REISCH, RENNICK);
- one licensed physical therapist assistant (SHANAHAN); and
- two public members interested in consumer rights, who are not otherwise eligible, and who are not related to a physical therapist or assistant (HAHN, TERRY).

The physical therapists or physical therapist assistants may be selected from a list of nominees submitted by the Oregon Physical Therapy Association. The physical therapists must possess unrestricted licenses, must have practiced in Oregon for at least two years immediately preceding their appointment, and must have been practiced physical therapy for at least five years.

Members serve four-year terms and are eligible for reappointment. A member must be removed immediately if, during the member's term, the member fails to maintain the criteria for appointment or has three consecutive unexcused absences.

Duties⁵

The board regulates the practice of physical therapy in Oregon.

The board must:

- administer licenses for physical therapists and physical therapist assistants and maintain a current list of licensees;
- establish and assess specified fees;
- provide public information about the procedure for filing a complaint; and
- publish final disciplinary actions taken, and other information to guide individuals regulated by the board.

The board may also:

- issue temporary permits without examination;
- impose sanctions for specified violations; and
- · receive complaints and initiate investigations.
