OREGON HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Oregon Human Rights Commission subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Composition³

The commission has nine members and includes:4

- one individual who has an intellectual or developmental disability and who receives community-based services from Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS) (PLOURDE);
- one family member of an individual who has an intellectual or developmental disability (MAXEY);
- one sibling of an individual who has an intellectual or developmental disability (JOHNSON);

- one self-advocate for the rights of individuals who have intellectual or developmental disabilities and who is a representative of an organization that promotes disability self-advocacy (GUEDON);
- two representatives from a disabilities advocacy organization (VACANT, VACANT);
- one service provider identified in the individualized service plan of an individual with an intellectual or developmental disability (SMITH);
- one representative of ODHS (SAHR); and
- one behavioral intervention model expert approved by ODHS (SEARLE).

Members may serve no more than two consecutive terms. The Governor must solicit recommendations from the Oregon Council on Developmental Disabilities and Disability Rights Oregon. The commission elects its chair. A majority of the members constitutes a quorum.

Duties⁵

The commission safeguards the dignity and basic human rights of individuals who have intellectual or developmental disabilities. The commission must:

- receive complaints of violations of the rights of persons receiving developmental disability services; and
- establish a statewide regional advisory committee system for committees to conduct informational hearings about the violation of those rights.

The commission may:

- with the consent, request and receive relevant information from ODHS about a received complaint;
- meet with the ODHS Director or a designee to resolve a complaint;
- appoint medical, behavioral and educational professionals in an advisory capacity; and
- · adopt any rules.
