PUBLIC RECORDS ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Public Records Advisory Council subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Composition³

The council consists of 14 members, including:

- a representative of the news media who is a member in good standing of a professional journalism association (WALTH);
- two additional representatives of the news media (KEARNS MOORE, SUO);
- a representative of the cities (STAUFFER);
- a representative of the counties (GLASSON);
- a special districts representative (LANDAUER);

- a public sector workforce representative (GOTHARD);
- a member of the public (HERNANDEZ);
- the Secretary of State or designee (RUNKLES);
- the Attorney General or designee (KRON);
- the Oregon Department of Administrative Services Director or designee (CHIAPELLA);
- a Senator, appointed by the President of the Senate, ex officio, nonvoting (THATCHER);
- a Representative, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, ex officio, nonvoting (ANDERSEN); and
- the Public Records Advocate (ALBERT).

Appointed members serve two-year terms and are eligible for reappointment. A majority of the voting members constitutes a quorum. The council must meet at least once every six months.

Duties⁴

The council works with the Public Records Advocate and the State Archives Division to study and make recommendations concerning the advocate's role, as well as practices, procedures, exemptions, and fees related to public records.

The council must:

- nominate three qualified individuals to serve as the Public Records Advocate;
- periodically survey state agency and other public body practices and procedures for: receiving public records requests, identifying the existence of responsive records and gathering and disclosing them; determining fee estimates and imposing or waiving fees; and determining and applying exemptions;
- periodically examine practices in other jurisdictions;
- identify inefficiencies and inconsistencies in application of the public records law;
- make recommendations for changes in law, policy, or practice that could enhance transparency;
- make recommendations on the role of the Public Records Advocate as facilitator in disputes between custodians of public records and public record requesters; and
- submit to the Governor and to the Legislative Assembly a biennial report that describes the findings of the council.

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The council may:

- prepare reports and studies at its discretion; and
- adopt rules governing the operations of the office of the Public Records Advocate, including rules establishing procedures for the conduct of facilitated dispute resolution.
