# **COMMISSION FOR THE BLIND**

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Commission for the Blind subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### **New Appointee**

Cassie Trosper of North Bend

## **Re-Appointee**

Alan Labrum of Portland

## Terms

Labrum: October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2027 Trosper: February 16, 2024 – February 15, 2028

## **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 346.130 (2023)

#### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

## **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of seven members that include:

- four blind individuals (BROOME, CARLILE-SMITH, GOODMAN, TROSPER); and
- three individuals from among:
  - employers (HUDSON);
  - o labor;
  - optometry (LABRUM);
  - o ophthalmology; and
  - o education of persons who are blind (MCCALLUM).

Only one appointee may represent the same area during the same term. Appointments should be made from the five areas on a rotating basis. Members serve four-year terms

and are removed from office if absent from three consecutive meetings or more than one-third of the scheduled meetings in one year.

## Duties<sup>4</sup>

The commission serves the needs of Oregon's citizens who experience vision loss and need specialized training and support to lead full and productive lives. Its duties include:

- establishing and administering programs for the welfare of persons with visual impairments, including cooperation by contract or otherwise with public and private agencies in providing services, programs, and facilities for persons with visual impairments;
- responsibility for the fiscal oversight, including development of the commission's budget, review of financial statements, and directing resources to implement program goals;
- employing an administrator;
- maintaining a confidential register of persons who are blind, describing the extent of blindness, and other information;
- administering programs for the conservation and restoration of sight and the prevention of blindness, and for vocational rehabilitation;
- cooperating with Department of Human Services to administer programs;
- overseeing the administration of vending facilities in public buildings or on public property; and
- ensuring the active participation of the commission's business enterprise consumer committee in major administrative, policy, and program development decisions that impact the commission's business enterprise program.

The commission may:

- establish social and educational services;
- enter into agreements with, join with, or accept grants from, the federal government for cooperative research, demonstration projects, and personnel training programs;
- receive moneys by gift or bequest;
- require the fingerprints of persons to check criminal history;
- aid a licensed vending facility manager with materials, equipment or machinery, or by allowing the manager to subcontract with a third party to obtain the above, in order to enable the operation of a vending facility; and
- negotiate and consummate arrangements for the purchase of such vending facility equipment.
