## **TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION**

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of 17 members, including:<sup>4</sup>

• four elementary school teachers (CARRASCO, JIMENEZ, KHALIL, VACANT);

- four middle school or high school teachers (GARCIA ARRIOLA, BARNEY, CLASSEN, YORK);
- one elementary school administrator (VACANT);
- one middle school or high school administrator (BARE);
- one superintendent of a school district (ZWEMKE);
- one superintendent of an education service district (WALTENBURG);
- one faculty member of an approved educator preparation provider within a private college or university (KONDOR);
- one faculty member of an approved educator preparation provider within a public university (NEWMAN);
- one school district board member (YING);
- one classified staff member at a public school or for an education service district (VACANT); and
- one public member (GROSS).

Members serve three-year terms. One member must be a licensed teacher with a special education endorsement or have related experience. Except for public members and school district board members, members must have been actively engaged in their respective occupations for five years immediately preceding appointment. The commission selects its chair and vice chair and meets at least once every six months.

#### **Duties**<sup>5</sup>

The commission regulates teaching programs offered by colleges and universities; licensure for teachers, administrators, and other personnel; and disciplines educators.

The commission must:

- appoint an executive director;
- administer licensing for educators and other personnel employed in schools;
- adopt rules for administering specified statutes;
- establish a public charter school teacher and administrator registry;
- administer a pilot program on alternative authorization requirements for teachers of noncore courses;
- establish and collect fees;
- adopt standards for approving educator preparation providers and programs;
- award grants from the Teacher Education Program Accreditation Account;

- assess proficiencies developed through Braille courses that are consistent with national standards; and
- investigate complaints, render decisions, and publish information about individuals subject to discipline.

The commission may:

- accept any grant, donation, or gift for the National Board Certification Fund;
- disburse moneys from the National Board Certification Fund to applicants for financial assistance with costs of obtaining national board certification;
- establish teaching licenses as necessary for operation of public schools;
- refuse to issue, or suspend or revoke, a license or registration; and
- issue a license to an out-of-state applicant if professional requirements are met.
