VICTIMS' RIGHTS PACKAGE HB 4146

Closing loopholes and increasing victims' access to justice in two ways:

REVENGE PORN FIX

Oregon statute requires that victims of revenge porn be "identifiable" in the explicit photos shared of them.

This has led to instances where courts cannot convict perpetrators because the victims were not identifiable solely through the photo, even if they could be through additional relevant evidence.

This package removes the word "identifiable" from the statute, effectively closing this loophole.











RESTRAINING ORDER EXPANSION

Domestic and sexual violence survivors can currently file for restraining orders in the counties where they or their abusers reside.

This package expands these options to also allow survivors to file for where the abuse occurred, an option currently only available to victims of stalking.
