Measure Description

The measure provides a one-time \$6 million General Fund appropriation to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) for the biennium ending June 30,2025, for distribution to the following institutions:

- Portland State University (PSU): \$2 million
- Eastern Oregon University (EOU): \$1 million
- Oregon Institute of Technology (OIT): \$1 million
- Southern Oregon University (SOU): \$1 million
- Western Oregon University (WOU): \$1 million

Fiscal Analysis

The fiscal impact of the measure is \$6 million General Fund for the 2023-25 biennium.

Higher Education Coordinating Commission

The fiscal impact on HECC is \$6 million General Fund for the 2023-25 biennium. The agency reports that the administrative duties for distributing the special payments to public universities can be absorbed within current resources.

Public Universities

The fiscal impact on PSU is \$2 million. The fiscal impact on EOU, OIT, SOU, and WOU is \$1 million each. The measure directs the institutions to use the funds for specified education and training purposes to expand the behavioral health workforce in Oregon.

Relevant Dates

The measure declares an emergency and takes effect on passage.
