## **Measure Description**

The measure provides a one-time \$6 million General Fund appropriation to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) for the biennium ending June 30,2025, for distribution to the following institutions:

- Portland State University (PSU): \$2 million
- Eastern Oregon University (EOU): \$1 million
- Oregon Institute of Technology (OIT): \$1 million
- Southern Oregon University (SOU): \$1 million
- Western Oregon University (WOU): \$1 million

# **Fiscal Analysis**

The fiscal impact of the measure is \$6 million General Fund for the 2023-25 biennium.

# Higher Education Coordinating Commission

The fiscal impact on HECC is \$6 million General Fund for the 2023-25 biennium. The agency reports that the administrative duties for distributing the special payments to public universities can be absorbed within current resources.

## Public Universities

With passage of this measure, PSU will receive \$2 million, and EOU, OIT, SOU, and WOU will receive \$1 million each in state funding. The measure directs the institutions to use the funds for specified education and training purposes to expand the behavioral health workforce in Oregon.

## **Relevant Dates**

The measure declares an emergency and takes effect on passage.
