## **Summary of Revenue Changes**

House Bill 4086 appropriates \$230,946 General Fund to the Department of Human Services (DHS) and increases Federal Funds expenditure limitation by \$77,640 to commission a study on the scope of child abuse investigations in Oregon and a study on the response to children exhibiting problematic sexual behavior. The source of Federal revenues is Title IV-E entitlement grant funds.

## **Summary of Capital Construction Subcommittee Action**

House Bill 4086 requires DHS to commission two studies: one on the scope of child abuse investigations in the state and one on Oregon's response to children exhibiting problematic sexual behavior. For each study, the bill requires DHS to contract with a facilitator specializing in public policy to conduct the study, appoint a committee to advise the facilitator in their research, and provide interim and final reports on findings and recommendations to the legislative assembly on September 30, 2024, and September 15, 2025.

The Subcommittee approved an increase of \$230,946 to the General Fund appropriation and an increase of \$77,640 Federal Funds expenditure limitation for DHS' Child Welfare program to contract for the required studies and support committee costs. Some level of funding may be needed in the 2025-27 biennium to complete the final reports. No funding related to the bill should be needed beyond the 2025-27 biennium.
