

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1530

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
3 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for deposit into the General
4 Housing Account under ORS 458.620, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the Gen-
5 eral Fund, the following amounts:

6 “(1) \$65,000,000 for the operations, services and administration of emergency shelters, as
7 defined in ORS 197.782.

8 “(2) \$40,000,000 for homelessness prevention services, including those delivered through
9 the Oregon Eviction Diversion and Prevention and Eviction Prevention Rapid Response Pro-
10 grams, as well as services administered by culturally responsive organizations, as defined in
11 ORS 456.005.

12 “(3) \$10,000,000 to acquire lands for the purpose of affordable housing development.

13 “(4) \$5,000,000 to provide matching funds for deposits into individual development ac-
14 counts under ORS 458.675 to 458.700.

15 “(5) \$2,000,000 to provide support for residents whose housing may be withdrawn from
16 publicly supported housing or is within a manufactured dwelling park being sold or closed.

17 “**SECTION 2.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
18 priated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium ending June
19 30, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts:

20 “(1) \$100,000,000 to distribute for infrastructure projects that will support the develop-
21 ment of housing.

22 “(2) \$1,000,000, to distribute to a nonprofit organization to donate reused household goods
23 and furnishings to low-income residents across this state.

24 “**SECTION 3.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
25 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the
26 General Fund, the following amounts:

27 “(1) \$18,000,000 for recovery housing projects.

28 “(2) \$7,500,000 for deposit into the Healthy Homes Repair Fund under ORS 431A.402.

29 “(3) \$3,500,000 to provide air conditioners and air filters under ORS 431A.430.

30 “**SECTION 4.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
31 priated to the State Department of Energy, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the
32 General Fund, the amount of \$4,000,000 for deposit into the Residential Heat Pump Fund
33 under section 21, chapter 86, Oregon Laws 2022.

34 “**SECTION 5.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
35 priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of

1 the General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, to provide support for warming or cooling
2 emergency shelters or facilities as described in ORS 431A.410.

3 SECTION 6. This 2024 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
4 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect
5 on its passage.”

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
