Senate Bill 1535

SUMMARY

It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Allows school districts to use students for work in district. (Flesch Readability Score: 78.2).

Authorizes district school boards to establish a policy to encourage students to develop vocational skills by performing maintenance tasks for school districts.
