**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1530**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
4 **ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services**
5 **Department, for deposit into the General Housing Account under ORS**
6 **458.620, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the General**
7 **Fund, the following amounts:**

8 **“(1) \$65,000,000 for the operations, services and administration of**
9 **emergency shelters, as defined in ORS 197.782.**

10 **“(2) \$40,000,000 for homelessness prevention services, including**
11 **those delivered through the Oregon Eviction Diversion and Prevention**
12 **and Eviction Prevention Rapid Response Programs, as well as services**
13 **administered by culturally responsive organizations, as defined in ORS**
14 **456.005.**

15 **“(3) \$10,000,000 to acquire lands for the purpose of affordable hous-**
16 **ing development.**

17 **“(4) \$5,000,000 to provide matching funds for deposits into individual**
18 **development accounts under ORS 458.675 to 458.700.**

19 **“(5) \$2,000,000 to provide support for residents whose housing may**
20 **be withdrawn from publicly supported housing or is within a manu-**
21 **factured dwelling park being sold or closed.**

1 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
2 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
3 **tive Services, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the General**
4 **Fund, the following amounts:**

5 **“(1) \$100,000,000 to distribute for infrastructure projects that will**
6 **support the development of housing.**

7 **“(2) \$1,000,000, to distribute to a nonprofit organization to donate**
8 **reused household goods and furnishings to low-income residents across**
9 **this state.**

10 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
11 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the**
12 **biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following**
13 **amounts:**

14 **“(1) \$18,000,000 for recovery housing projects.**

15 **“(2) \$7,500,000 for deposit into the Healthy Homes Repair Fund un-**
16 **der ORS 431A.402.**

17 **“(3) \$3,500,000 to provide air conditioners and air filters under ORS**
18 **431A.430.**

19 **“SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
20 **ation, there is appropriated to the State Department of Energy, for the**
21 **biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount**
22 **of \$4,000,000 for deposit into the Residential Heat Pump Fund under**
23 **section 21, chapter 86, Oregon Laws 2022.**

24 **“SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
25 **ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for**
26 **the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the General Fund, the**
27 **amount of \$2,000,000, to provide support for warming or cooling emer-**
28 **gency shelters or facilities as described in ORS 431A.410.**

29 **“SECTION 6. This 2024 Act being necessary for the immediate**
30 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**

1 **declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
