**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4136**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete the comma and insert “and”
2 and delete “and 678.040”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 44 and 45.

4 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 26.

5 In line 27, delete “4” and insert “3” and delete “(1)”.

6 Delete lines 30 and 31.

7 In line 35, delete “5” and insert “4”.

8 Delete lines 41 through 45 and insert:

9 “(b) To fund a health care access innovation fund to finance innovations
10 that are designed to improve access to same-day health care while decreasing
11 the overall same-day health care system costs in the greater Eugene area.
12 As described in this paragraph:

13 “(A) The innovations may include, but are not limited to, a nurse advice
14 line, community health care response programs, alternative medical trans-
15 portation options and programming to improve access to health care while
16 reducing emergency department utilization.

17 “(B) The costs may include, but are not limited to, costs related to
18 emergency medical services, emergency department utilization and 9-1-1
19 emergency calls.”.

20 On page 4, delete lines 2 through 20 and insert:

21 “(a) Lane County Public Health to solicit, review and select proposals for

1 the innovations described in subsection (1)(b) of this section, and to consult
2 with coordinated care organizations and other stakeholders to optimize the
3 use of funds described in subsection (1)(b) of this section and leverage addi-
4 tional funding from other sources.

5 “(b) Lane County Public Health to submit a report in the manner pro-
6 vided in ORS 192.245, which may include recommendations for legislation,
7 to the authority and the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-
8 lated to health care not later than December 31, 2024. The report described
9 in this paragraph must include a detailed description of how the funds de-
10 scribed in subsection (1)(b) of this section administered by Lane County
11 Public Health are used.

12 “(c) Lane County Public Health and the authority to submit a report in
13 the manner provided in ORS 192.245, which may include recommendations for
14 legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to
15 health care not later than December 31, 2025. The report described in this
16 paragraph must include a detailed description of how the funds described in
17 subsection (1)(b) of this section administered by Lane County Public Health
18 are used and whether and to what degree the innovations described in sub-
19 section (1)(b) of this section achieved the objectives of subsection (1)(b) of
20 this section.

21 “(3) The agreement entered into under subsection (1) of this section must
22 allow Lane County Public Health to withhold from the funds administered
23 under subsection (1) of this section a reasonable amount to reimburse Lane
24 County Public Health for administrative costs incurred under this section.”.

25 In line 21, delete “6” and insert “5”.

26 In line 24, delete “5” and insert “4”.

27 After line 24, insert:

28 **“SECTION 6. Of the moneys appropriated under section 5 of this**
29 **2024 Act, the Oregon Health Authority shall use:**

30 **“(1) \$1,300,000 for carrying out the provisions of section 4 (1)(a) of**

1 **this 2024 Act; and**

2 **“(2) \$3,200,000 for carrying out the provisions of section 4 (1)(b) of**
3 **this 2024 Act.”.**

4 In line 25, delete “5 and 6” and insert “4 to 6”.

5 Delete lines 27 through 37.

6 In line 41, delete “10” and insert “8”.

7 On page 5, line 1, delete “11” and insert “9”.
