**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1537**

1 On page 37 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 21 through 42 and
2 insert:

3 **“SECTION 61. Appropriation and expenditure limitation to Depart-**
4 **ment of Land Conservation and Development.** (1) In addition to and
5 **not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the**
6 **Department of Land Conservation and Development, for the biennium**
7 **ending June 30, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of**
8 **\$5,629,017, for deposit into the Housing Accountability and Production**
9 **Office Fund, established under section 4 of this 2024 Act, to take any**
10 **action to implement sections 1 to 5, 16, 38 to 41, 46 and 49 to 59 of this**
11 **2024 Act and the amendments to ORS 183.471, 197.015, 197.195, 197.335,**
12 **215.427 and 227.178 by sections 8, 9, 44, 45, 64 and 65 of this 2024 Act.**

13 **“(2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there**
14 **is appropriated to the Department of Land Conservation and Develop-**
15 **ment, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the General Fund,**
16 **the amount of \$5,000,000, for deposit into the Housing Accountability**
17 **and Production Office Fund, established under section 4 of this 2024**
18 **Act, for the Housing Accountability and Production Office, established**
19 **under section 1 of this 2024 Act, to provide technical assistance, in-**
20 **cluding grants, under section 1 (2) of this 2024 Act and to provide re-**
21 **quired studies under section 5 of this 2024 Act.**

1 “(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the
2 amount of \$10,629,017 is established for the biennium ending June 30,
3 2025, as the maximum amount for payment of expenses by the De-
4 partment of Land Conservation and Development from the Housing
5 Accountability and Production Office Fund established under section
6 4 of this 2024 Act.

7 “SECTION 62. Appropriation and expenditure limitation to Housing
8 and Community Services Department. (1) In addition to and not in lieu
9 of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and
10 Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30,
11 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$75,000,000, for deposit
12 into the Housing Project Revolving Loan Fund established under sec-
13 tion 35 of this 2024 Act.

14 “(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
15 appropriation made to the Housing and Community Services Depart-
16 ment by section 1, chapter 390, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
17 ending June 30, 2025, is increased by \$878,071 for administrative ex-
18 penses related to the Housing Project Revolving Loan Fund established
19 under section 35 of this 2024 Act.

20 “(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the
21 amount of \$24,750,000 is established for the biennium ending June 30,
22 2025, as the maximum amount for payment of expenses by the Housing
23 and Community Services Department from the Housing Project Re-
24 volving Loan Fund established under section 35 of this 2024 Act.

25 “SECTION 63. Appropriation and expenditure limitation to Oregon
26 Business Development Department. (1) In addition to and not in lieu
27 of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Busi-
28 ness Development Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025,
29 out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, for deposit into the
30 Housing Infrastructure Support Fund established under section 14 of

1 **this 2024 Act.**

2 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the**
3 **amount of \$3,000,000 is established for the biennium ending June 30,**
4 **2025, as the maximum amount for payment of expenses by the Oregon**
5 **Business Development Department from the Housing Infrastructure**
6 **Support Fund established under section 14 of this 2024 Act.**

7 **“SECTION 63a. Expenditure limitation to Department of Consumer**
8 **and Business Services. Notwithstanding any other law limiting ex-**
9 **penditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (6),**
10 **chapter 354, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025,**
11 **as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**
12 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lot-**
13 **tery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department**
14 **of Consumer and Business Services, for Building Codes Division, is**
15 **increased by \$296,944, to support operations of the Housing Account-**
16 **ability and Production Office established under section 1 of this 2024**
17 **Act.”.**
