**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4129**

1 On page 10 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 22, insert:

2 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
3 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Human Ser-**
4 **vices by section 1 (6), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium**
5 **ending June 30, 2025, for aging and people with disabilities programs,**
6 **is increased by \$414,498 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.**

7 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
8 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 3 (6), chapter 610,**
9 **Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-**
10 **imum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding**
11 **federal funds described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023,**
12 **collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for aging**
13 **and people with disabilities programs, is increased by \$414,498 for car-**
14 **rying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.**

15 **“SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
16 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Human Ser-**
17 **vices by section 1 (2), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium**
18 **ending June 30, 2025, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs,**
19 **is increased by \$60,041 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.**

20 **“SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
21 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter 610,**

1 Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$766 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

11 **“SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 3 (2), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$52,638 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

19 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for shared services, is increased by \$158,179 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

30 **“SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the

1 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by
2 section 1 (2), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending
3 June 30, 2025, for Health Systems Division - Programs, is increased by
4 \$926,738 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

5 **“SECTION 13.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
6 the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (2), chapter 591,
7 Oregon Laws 2023 for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the maxi-
8 mum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding
9 federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,
10 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for Health Sys-
11 tems Division - Programs, is increased by \$1,003,003 for carrying out
12 sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

13 **“SECTION 14.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
14 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by
15 section 1 (7), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending
16 June 30, 2025, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is in-
17 creased by \$34,225 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

18 **“SECTION 15.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
19 the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (10), chapter
20 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the
21 maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other
22 revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax receipts,
23 marijuana tax receipts, beer and wine tax receipts, provider taxes and
24 Medicare receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not
25 described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or re-
26 ceived by the Oregon Health Authority, for shared administrative
27 services, is increased by \$1,235 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this
28 2024 Act.

29 **“SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
30 the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (7), chapter 591,

1 **Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-**
2 **imum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding**
3 **federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,**
4 **collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for state as-**
5 **sessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$27,688 for carry-**
6 **ing out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.”.**

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
