**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1578**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 15, after “access” insert
2 “for Oregon Health Plan members”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 7 through 11 and insert:

4 “(a) Provide an online scheduling mechanism that health care providers,
5 including coordinated care organizations, may use to directly schedule ap-
6 pointments with certified and qualified health care interpreters for purposes
7 of serving Oregon Health Plan members; and

8 “(b) Process billing and payments for health care interpreter services that
9 were rendered to Oregon Health Plan members and scheduled through the
10 interpreter management system.”.

11 In line 39, after “to” delete the rest of the line and delete line 40 and
12 insert “Oregon Health Plan members.” and begin a new paragraph and insert:

13 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
14 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by
15 section 1 (1), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending
16 June 30, 2025, for Health Systems Division - Administration, is in-
17 creased by \$280,274, for carrying out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and
18 4 of this 2024 Act.**

19 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
20 the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (1), chapter 591,
21 Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-**

1 imum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding
2 federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,
3 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for Health Ser-
4 vices Division - Administration, is increased by \$280,274, for carrying
5 out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.

6 **SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
7 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by
8 section 1 (6), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending
9 June 30, 2025, for central services, is increased by \$260,000, for carrying
10 out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.

11 **SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
12 the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (6), chapter 591,
13 Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-
14 imum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding
15 federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,
16 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for central ser-
17 vices, is increased by \$240,000, for carrying out the provisions of
18 sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.

19 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
20 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by
21 section 1 (7), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending
22 June 30, 2025, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is in-
23 creased by \$6,856, for carrying out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and
24 4 of this 2024 Act.

25 **SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
26 the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (7), chapter 591,
27 Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-
28 imum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding
29 federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,
30 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for state as-

1 assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$6,856, for carry-
2 ing out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.

3 **“SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
4 the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (10), chapter
5 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the
6 maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other
7 revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax receipts,
8 marijuana tax receipts, beer and wine tax receipts, provider taxes and
9 Medicare receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not
10 described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or re-
11 ceived by the Oregon Health Authority, for shared administrative
12 services, is increased by \$302,148, for carrying out the provisions of
13 sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.”.**

14 In line 41, delete “5” and insert “12”.

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
