HB4070 Leverages Millions of \$ for Local Schools

HEALTH TOOLS FOR SCHOOLS



Provides Flexible Funding for School Health Services:

Allow districts to pursue what fits best for them: a school-based health center, school nurse, mental health, or a trauma informed schools program based on priorities and existing resources and community engagement.

Extra funds (\$6.75 million) to meet the severe mental health crisis in our schools, both those with and those without SBHCs, rural and urban, large and small.

10 more schools could take advantage of potential tele-health billing for school nursing services (for a total of around 100): This could:

Increase access to health services for youth in schools where there is not a SBHC, by connecting a school nurse in one school to a SBHC in a different location using telehealth
...and maximize billing of public and private insurance, and potentially generating millions from non-GF sources for nursing

Developed by over 60 local & community organizations

10 more districts (up from the existing 91 by fall 2023) could **generate up to \$5.2 million each biennium in non-state Medicaid/private insurance/foundation support** for school health -
- 4 X the state investment!

All schools with SBHCs could take advantage of a pilot system to bill for nursing services, **generating Medicaid/private insurance revenues from non state sources!** This was a key goal of the School Nursing Task Force.
