On behalf of the Family Justice Center and its partners, I urge your support of HB4123. This bill will provide stop-gap funding for the ongoing work of the SANE/SAE Coordinating Council's work on statewide, interdisciplinary sexual assault response across. This work is especially jeopardized in rural areas, often resulting in victims of sexual assault driving hundreds of miles to reach qualified care. The SCC operates in partnership with the AG's Sexual Assault Task Force. It is critical for survivors to have highly-trained forensic nurse examiners, and many communities across the state do not have the access, putting both survivors and their cases in jeopardy.
