My name is John Herrera, and I serve as Director of Catholic Charities Immigration Legal Services.

Catholic Charities of Oregon enthusiastically supports HB 4085, Pathways to Protection and Citizenship.

Up to 1 in 3 Oregonians who lack documentation are eligible under existing federal law for protection, but lack access to immigration legal assistance.

More than half of foreign-born Oregonians have become U.S. citizens since immigrating to the United States. The overwhelming majority of immigrant Oregonians value becoming naturalized citizens, fully participating in the privileges of citizenship. However, tens of thousands of Oregonians are unable to afford immigration legal services.

Proactive affirmative immigration legal services will create pathways to citizenship and provide safety, security and stability for our immigrant and refugee communities.
