A robust guardianship program is needed in Oregon. Especially for adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities who may be vulnerable and lack adequate supports and protections. As it stands there are not enough resources to support all of the people in need of this assistance. So, individuals end up on waitlists, or sometimes fail to get a guardian when they need one desperately, as a result ending up in jail, the hospital or worse.
