Oregon Voter Housing Preferences

84%

Percentage of Oregonians who believe housing affordability is a very big problem (57%) or fairly big problem (27%)

76%

Percentage of Oregonians who believe that there is not enough housing for Oregonians with moderate incomes. This is the housing we need for our teachers, nurses, fire-fighters, and civil servants.

79%

Percentage of Oregonians who would prefer to live in a single-family home as opposed to either a townhouse, low-rise apartment or condo or mid- to high-rise apartment or condo

67%

Percentage of Oregonians who identify with the statement "we need more affordable housing options that meet the budget and preferences of consumers, even if that uses more land and creates more carbon emissions."

75%

Percentage of Oregonians who would prefer a detached single family house that requires driving to amenities
