Chair Jama, Vice Chair Anderson, and members of the Committee, thank you for your time. For the record, my name is Matt Wellner. I am here on behalf of Crandall Group, a real estate Brokerage and land development firm based in Beaverton. My background is in planning, land use, and land development. I work on both UGB expansion areas and infill projects, from concept, through site development. I have for more than 25 years.
